## Family Talk- Luke 6:37-42

### Forgiveness: Luke 6:37

- Jesus' main point on forgiveness is that self-righteous people often judge and condemn those who wrong them, while forgiven people who have been saved by the gospel should forgive those who wrong them.
- Q: Is there anyone in your life who you need to forgive?

### Generosity: Luke 6:38

- Jesus teaches us that His disciples should be generous with their money and resources because God has been so generous to them. He also says as Christian's practice generosity towards God and others, God is likely to bless them with more, so they can continue to be generous and bless others.
- Q: How can we as individuals and as a family be more generous?

### Influence: Luke 6:39-40

- We first need to realize that all of us are both leaders and followers. No matter how big or small your leadership is, someone is watching you and following your lead.
- Question for leaders: If someone were to follow your life where would they end up?
  - Closer to Christ or farther away?
- Question for the followers: Who or what are you being influenced by?
  - Jesus says we will become like our influences for good or bad.
- Q: Are there bad influences in your life that need changing?
  - (Friends, TV shows, Music, Books, etc.)

### Hypocrisy: Luke 6:41-42

- Jesus defines hypocrisy as dealing with everyone else's sin, while ignoring your own. Jesus warns us to avoid hypocrisy by first dealing with our own sin, before we call out others for theirs.
- Q: What log is in my own eye that I need to repent of?
