## How Powerful are the Words of Christ?

### Read: Luke 7:1-10

- According to the Jews, this Centurion is worthy or unworthy of Jesus?
  - Worthy - (He serves his country, loves Israel, built their synagogue)
- According to the Centurion himself, is he worthy or unworthy of Jesus?
  - Unworthy - (Even though he looked good on the outside, he knew on the inside he was unworthy of Jesus)
- What does this Centurion believe about Jesus' authority?
  - A: He has all authority, even authority over sickness
- What does Jesus do simple by speaking?
  - A: Heals the Centurion's servant

### Read Luke 7:11-17

- What does Jesus do simple by speaking in this text?
  - A: Raises a man from the dead

### Questions:

- What do these verses teach us about the Word's of Jesus?
  - A: They are powerful and authoritative
- How does Jesus still speak to us today?
  - A: Through the Bible, His written Word.
- What does 2 Timothy 3:16 teach us about God's Word?
  - It is God-breathed and profitable to us
- If Jesus still speaks to us through His Word, and those Words are powerful and authoritative for our lives, what should we do on a consistent basis?
  - Read God's Word and live according to what He says.

### Family Application:

- This week as a family we are each going to read and meditate on Psalm 1 for personal devotion time with Christ. Read and meditate on this text at least three times this week, as you strengthen your relationship with Him through His Word.
