Is Jesus the ONE?

Luke 7:18-35

- In this text John the Baptist sends his disciples to ask Jesus if He is the one (the Messiah). In the text Jesus answers, “Yes” by fulfilling Isaiah 35:5-6 and healing many people in the presence of John’s disciples. Going off the simple question, “Is Jesus the one?” as a family we are going to look at the Bible and ask the question, “Who is Jesus?”
- John 6:38 - Jesus came down from heaven
 - (Jesus is claiming He is originally from heaven and not earth)
- Mark 10:17 - Jesus is more than a good teacher
 - (Jesus wanted this man to see He was not merely a good teacher, but God)
- Hebrews 4:15 - Jesus was sinless
 - (Jesus was tempted just like we are, yet He never sinned)
- Luke 7:21-33 - Jesus performed miracles
 - Read Isaiah 35:5-6 and discuss how these miracles confirm Jesus’ identity.
- Mark 14:61-62 - Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God
 - (Pilot asks Jesus plainly if He is the Messiah, the Son of God and Jesus says, “I am.”)
 - Read Daniel 7:13-14 and discuss why the title “Son of man” is significant.
- John 8:58-59 - Jesus is God
 - Read Exodus 3:13-14 and answer this question, “Why did the people want to stone Jesus for saying, “Before Abraham, I am?”
 - (Because in saying, “Before Abraham, I am” Jesus was claiming to exist before Abraham as the eternal God of all creation)
- Luke 5:20-21 - Jesus forgives sin
 - Why did this make the religious leaders mad? (Only God can forgive Sin)
- Act 7:59 - Christians pray to Jesus
 - (Praying to Jesus means He is God in heaven)
- John 14:6 - Jesus is the only way to heaven
 - (Jesus is the Savior of the world who forgives sinners by His blood and reconciles them back to the Father)
